Q&A

- 1. Our tutoring costs are per hour and I see that the stipulation is no more than 6 periods per day, therefore we will charge per period. How long is a period?

 Periods are approximately 48 minutes.
- 2. I understand the district is looking for daily pricing based on 6 periods. Is the assumption all 100 students per school will be participating on a daily basis? In which case we would provide pricing for 50 groups of 2 for 1 period each or 100 individuals for 1 period each? The majority of our district programs has PPA caps and tends to only run 1-4 hours per week for a predetermined number of weeks. It would be 100 divided over the 5-6 periods of the day. That would be approximately 16-20 per period. At an approximate 1:2 tutor to student ratio you would need about 8-10 tutors per period. The tutoring would be a course on the student's schedule.
- 3. Do all 6 hardcopy responses have to be originals or can it be 1 original and 5 copies? 1 original and 5 copies is fine.
