71st Connecticut Science & Engineering Fair

Scofield Magnet Middle School Seventh Grader **Aryan Pandalai** took first place at the *71st Connecticut Science & Engineering Fair* in the Lockheed Martin Physical Science Seventh Grade category. A student of Scofield Technology Teacher **Louise McMinn**, Aryan earned the award for his project, *Water Quality of the Rippowam River*. The competition, with the objective of attracting young people to careers in mathematics, science and engineering while developing critical thinking and public speaking skills, was part of a statewide science and engineering fair open to all Connecticut students in grades 7 to 12. He will now compete at the *2019 Broadcom MASTERS* (Math, Applied Science, Technology, and Engineering for Rising Stars) competition this summer.

2019 National Scholastic Art and Writing Awards Competition
