Stamford High School (SHS) Senior Krantz Medeus and Toquam Elementary School Fourth Grader Alexander Barker were recently selected as the winners of the Student Space Flights Experiments Program (SSEP) Mission 12 Patch Art Design Contest. The contest was conducted by the Stamford High School Art Department in conjunction with SHS participation in the National Center for Earth and Space Science Education Mission 12 to the International Space Station SSEP program. The winning designs were selected out of a total of 544 entries from across the district by a panel of judges from the Stamford community. The patches will be worn by astronauts on Mission 12.

### **Global Navigator Scholars**
