The Connected Mathematics Program (CMP3) is a complete, standards based, mathematics curriculum that helps students develop understanding of important concepts, skills, procedures, and ways of thinking and reasoning in number, geometry, measurement, algebra, probability, and statistics.
- Scope & Sequence (course objectives, topics, standards)
The following units will be covered throughout the course of the school year:
Prime Time – factors and multiples
Covering and Surrounding – two-dimensional measurement
Data About Us – statistics and data analysis
Variables and Patterns – focus on algebra
Let's Be Rational – understanding fraction operations
Comparing Bits and Pieces – ratios, rational numbers, and equivalence
Decimal Ops – computing with decimals and percents
