

# Mathematic Academic Enrichment

### Course Syllabus

- **Course Description:** Math Enrichment is a course whereby students will receive math support, which will depend upon the specific needs of each student. The students will learn to value mathematics and become confident in their ability to do mathematics through a blended curriculum. Problems are introduced which cause students to revisit various strands of the curriculum, thereby highlighting the connections among different topics.
- **Scope & Sequence:** The sequence of activities will correlate specifically with their current math class in CMP.
- **Required Books and Materials:** Notebook (1 inch 3 Ring notebook binder with loose leaf paper), pencils, one colored pen, agenda book, pencil case, and a good attitude.
- **Academic and Behavioral Expectations:** All students are expected to have required materials which will be housed in class. Supplies include notebook (1 inch 3 ring notebook binder with loose leaf paper), 2 sharpened pencils, and a colored pencil or pen other than black or blue for correcting. For safety reasons, students will have their backpacks at the side of the room during class. We will be moving around the room. Homework is individual based. All work in the binder is expected to be complete.
- **Grading Policy:** Students are required to contribute to their success in this class by being prepared, participating, using respectable behavior, keeping their notebook organized. The students will be evaluated by the following percentages.
