Our mission is to keep your child healthy and happy while *in school* to avoid any unnecessary absences or time away from work for *you!*

Whether your child is sick or in need of counseling, the choice to use the School Based Health Center is yours. Each Health center is staffed by Board Certified Nurse Practitioners and Clinical Social Workers. Simply filling out our enrollment form allows your child to use any or all of our services, **regardless of income or health care coverage**. ALL school aged children in the City of Stamford can receive dental cleanings and fillings for cavities at our Dental Clinic in Rippowam Middle School.

SBHC services include:

- Physical examinations
- Immunizations
- Nutritional guidance
- Treatment of minor illnesses and injuries
- Preventive health education programs
- Referrals to specialists and medical follow up
- Laboratory Tests
- Asthma education and follow up
- Assessment of skin problems
- Individual and group counseling
