Overview:

**I am responsible for instructing either Orton-Gillingham or Scholastic System 44 to my students depending on their individual needs. Scholastic System 44 is a program in which the student is guided along a systematic path from phonemic awareness to fluent reading. This program relies heavily on the computer. The Orton-Gillingham is also a phonetically-based sequential, structured method which is extremely effective in the remediation of reading, spelling and writing.**

**In addition to working directly with the core teachers, I provide Academic Support to students with IEP's for one hour daily in a Resource setting. During this time the emphasis is on Language Arts, Math, Social Studies and Science. The instruction time is used to review the lessons, provide the additional skills needed to reinforce certain concepts and at times, offer a preview of the next day's lesson. I will also be working on the goals and objectives that are within their IEP's.**

Daily Materials:

**Please bring your pencils, books, and agenda book daily.**

Behavioral and Academic Expectations (homework policy):

**Our expectations for all students are very demanding. We expect all students to come to class prepared with homework, textbooks, as well as writing utensils.**

**We are very strict with our students and post expected behaviors. If children are disruptive, they are removed from class and written up. I call the parent with the child present. I usually give the child a detention with me during lunch, or at times, after school. For those serious continuing offenders, we provide a tracer which all teachers have to write something on throughout the day regarding the behavior of your child.**

**I am available 7:30 to 7:45 AM and then again after school from 3:00 to 4:00 Tuesdays and Fridays. If your child needs a quick review, then I am always available during our lunchtime. Parents, feel free to call me anytime!**
